The meeting started with the welcome note by Dr.(Mrs.) S.A. Bhide, Director,.

1. Confirmation of the minutes of the last meeting.

Minutes of the last meeting were read and confirmed by all the members present in the meeting.

2. Pradhan Mantri Yojanas as Best Practices.

The college had begun making plans for the future after being accredited with B+ by NAAC. The college considered enhancing its best practices. In light of this it was felt that our students should create awareness in the people of their surroundings of the Pradhan Mantri Yojanas so that more and more people could accrue benefit from these schemes. Our Director opined that this be introduced as a best practice.

The proposal was put forth to the Members present in the meeting. The IQAC Coordinator, Mrs. Suhashini Chaurasia, made a PPT presentation and discussed the various Pradhan Mantri Schemes. Ujjwala Yojana, Atal Pension Yojana, Sukanya Yojana, Awas Yojana, Startup India, Stand Up India, and Skill Development were a few among them. It was a hard reality that despite there being numerous government programs, few people took advantage of these yojanas since they were unaware of them. In fact all members of IQAC learned about various schemes for the first time.

Dr. Sudha Bhide outlined the procedure for implementing awareness of the yojanas in the college. She stated that we assigned one scheme to each teacher, and requested that the teachers should educate and inspire the pupils to educate others and assist them in taking advantage of the schemes. After presenting the PPT, Suhashini Chaurasia, IQAC coordinator requested the members to offer their suggestions for execution of this practice successfully. Dr. Sheel Ghule Member IQAC and Smart City Project in charge, NMC Nagpur, suggested that we could call the parents of students to the college and make them aware of these schemes. This suggestion was accepted by all the members.

3. Quality Enhancement

All educational institutions have a primary duty to continuously concentrate on improving their institution's quality. Mrs. Suhashini Chaurasia asked the members to provide their ideas for raising the standard and quality of education in the college. Mr. Hemant Golechha, a young



entrepreneur and member of IQAC, proposed that colleges ensure that every student has a LinkedIn profile, which can assist students in finding employment, receiving talent

endorsements, staying current, etc. He offered to deliver a seminar to the students on it, and the chairperson agreed.

Dr. Sheel Ghule proposed that he could arrange a visit to the Smart City project department where the students could learn about new methods of implementation of traffic management. They could see as to how traffic was managed under Smart city project. He added that his department was currently implementing smart toilets (biodiverse toilets) in Nagpur's busy places and QR codes for household waste management. He recommended educating pupils on each of these points. He also suggested to have an Incubation center in the college.

Mrs. Nisha Vyas Member and teacher's representative requested Dr. Sheel Ghule to arrange a visit to their department for the teachers also which was readily accepted by him. Dr. Sudha Bhide appreciated the work of the department and gave her consent for sending students and teachers to their department.

Mr. Darren James Member IQAC and student's representative suggested that it will be great to arrange a seminar on Artificial Intelligence for the students of all classes in this technological world. The suggestion was appreciated by all.

Dr. Diwakar Tripathi Teacher representative suggested that there must be a security guard at the college gate so that no outside students could enter the college premises.

4. ISO / NBA procedures

It was decided that procedures for ISO/ NBA certification be studied carefully to assess whether certification could be implemented.

5. Industry Requirement

Mrs. Suhashini Chaurasia requested the members to give their suggestions on how to get students ready for the workforce.

Mr. Rohan Singh alumnus of our college and a member of the IQAC, suggested that the college should offer Add On Courses that can assist students in adjusting to the demands of industry. Dr. Vrushali Parkhi suggested that a Personality development program be organized for the students.

Dr. Bhide Chairperson of IQAC and Director of the college assure that all ideas would be taken into consideration for the welfare of the students.

The Meeting concluded with a vote of thanks by IQAC Coordinator Mrs. Suhashini Chaurasia.
