  - BCCA final year students have done us proud. 33 students appeared for BCCA final year examination and all students have passed. The results are 100 %.
- 11. Application (provisional) for including our college under 2f of the UGC so that our college becomes eligible to receive grants from UGC has been forwarded by R.T.M. Nagpur University to the U.G.C. Shri Mudgal of VMV will follow up the

- matter with UGC for further processing after the Executive Committee approves the application.
- 12. 50 % construction of the fourth floor of the college has been completed.
- 13. Advertisement of our college was given on cable T.V. and was displayed for a month. This was discontinued since even otherwise we have a huge rush for admissions.
- 14. Prospectus for senior college as well as application form for Junior college has been printed.
- 15. Dr.(Mrs.) S.A. Bhide attended the co-ordination committee meeting of Junior College on 11<sup>th</sup> May, 2017. Heads of VMV college, Pakwasa High School and Umiyashankar High School were present in the meeting. The modalities of online admissions to XIth class were discussed.

#### 3. Proposal to start Junior College

b) As our proposal to start Junior College was not approved by the Govt. of Maharashtra, in 2015 -16, a fresh proposal has been sent and the same has been recommended by the Deputy Director of School Education, Nagpur, and forwarded to Education Dept., Mantralaya, Mumbai. c) A writ petition (WP no. 2394 of 2016) has been filed in the Nagpur bench of the Bombay High Court to permit us to start M.Com. course from session 2016-17 since the same was approved by R.T.M. Nagpur University but all proposals to start new courses from session 2015 of all colleges in Maharashtra were rejected by Higher and Technical Education dept. of Govt. of Maharashtra. Hon'ble Justice VasantiNaik has ordered the Govt. to tell the court on 6<sup>th</sup> of June, 2016, before next session begins as to whether or not they will grant permission to us to start M.Com. course from session 2016 – 2017.

#### 4. University Theory and Practical examinations.

The R.T.M. Nagpur University summer 2016 practical examinations for B.Sc.(I.T) III, M.Sc. I and II, and BCCA I,II, III as well as BBA III project have been completed. Practical examinations of B.Sc.(I.T.) I and II are scheduled for June 2016. R.T.M. Nagpur University summer 2016 theory examinations are ongoing.

#### 5. Infrastructure Development

- 1) Fabrication of about 80 desks and 80 benches was ordered and the same installed in the college to cater to increased student strength. Two tables werebrought from VMV college and repaired and are being used by the teaching staff.
- 2) 4 nosTerafil make water filters (one for each floor) approved by C.S.I.R and Govt. of India were purchased from Chennai for the students. As per C.S.I.R. this has been tested in various laboratories in India and abroad and gives potable water. One water filter has been installed on each floor.
- 3) One computer was purchased for the college staff.
- 4) A small garden has been developed in front of the college
- 5) An area in front of the college gate has been enclosed by a mesh to cater to parking of student's vehicles.
