

Activities 2015-16

1. International Day Against Drug Abuse and Illicit Trafficking

A speech by PSI Mr. Mohite and Mr. Mohan Dere was organized in our college on the occasion of Nasha Mukti Din, 26th June 2015. They delivered a detail and informative talk on side effects of drugs, alcohol and tobacco consumption to create awareness in the new generation. They also gave a print out of their ppt in which detailed information was displayed. This was put up on the notice board for students.



2. Celebration of World Population Day

As per notification of R.T.M.N.U. under Adult & Continued Education Program, two events such as Essay competition & Home Visit program were arranged in our college to celebrate World Population Day, 11 July, 2015.
