### **17. Guest Lecture of Mr. Hitesh Shahu (C.A.) and Mr. Harish Paliwal (C.S.)**

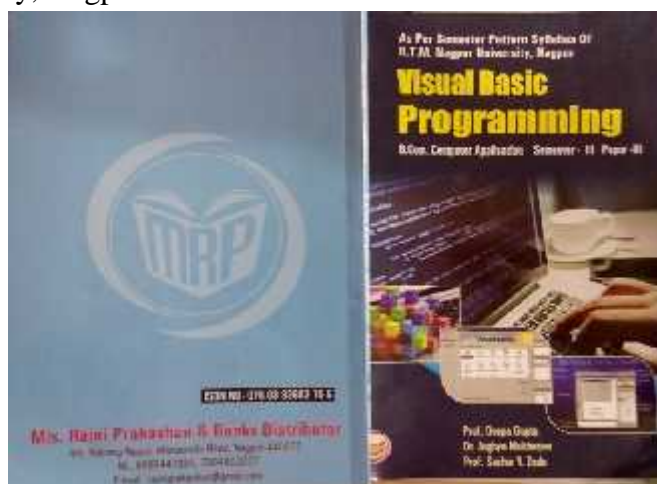

On receiving the permission from “Centre of Science for Villages, Dattapur, Wardha” 81 students from S.S.Maniar College of Computer and Management with 3 faculty members (Mr. Atul Akotkar, Ms. Gunjan Kharabe and Mrs. Suhashini Chaurasiya) and Director Dr. (Mrs.) S. A. Bhide went for an education tour to this centre on 23<sup>rd</sup> September, 2017. Bus reached the centre at 11:00 am. Since last three decades centre is working on Rural Technologies and providing training to farmers. They apply technology for producing innovative scientific products for rural areas that benefit both the people and environment. They gave information on Rural Housing (Mud house and Bamboo house), Sanitation (Leach pit toilet, Biogas, Agro waste Stove, etc.), Liquid waste management (Recycling unit, Rain water harvesting unit, Kitchen gardening, etc.), Eco-technology (Water shade management, Organic farming, Forestry, Honey from Box, etc.), Rural industries (Handmade paper, Pottery, Fabrication of tools, etc.) and Medicinal plants.

The tour was followed by visit to “Gandhi Kutli” at Sewagram, the place where Gandhiji stayed for many years. Since Gandhiji wanted to live like a simple peasant and to serve the nation through constructive and rural re-construction work, he emphasized the need of Ashram where the workers could be trained for bringing his dreams into reality. He had been thinking of moving to a village in order to engage himself directly in the work of rural reconstruction. In the meantime Jamnalal Bajaj suggested him for establishing the Ashram in a village, about four miles from Wardha. Most of the land of this village belonged to jamnalal bajaj. Gandhiji accepted the proposal and decided to move to Sevagram from Maganwadi. The “Ashram” had been set up under the direction of Bapu in the village "Segaon" in 1936, which has latter been named as "Sevagram Ashram" (Service village).

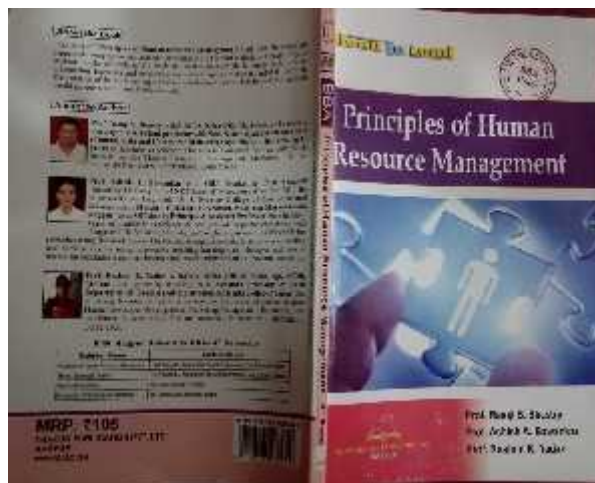
#### 40. Swachh Bharat Abhiyan Rally

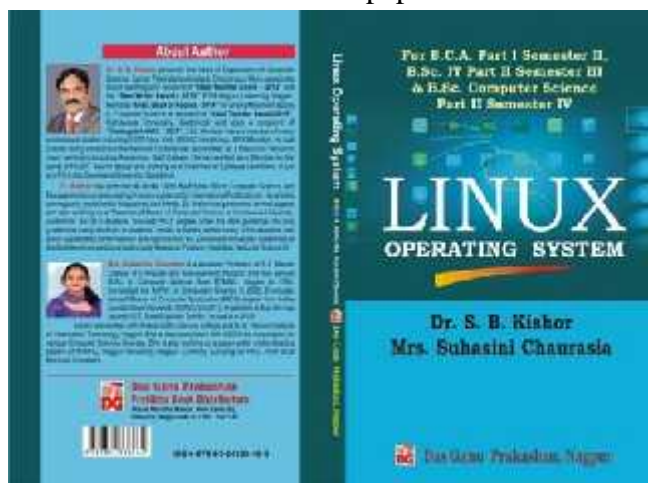
